

Orientation (8/17 - 8/20)

(Formerly known as Open House)

You will be able to access your student's class schedule through Infinite Campus.

You will be contacted by e-mail when the schedules are available.

Schedules may change after August 28th! Only then will we know our final numbers. Classes may need to be reshuffled in order to balance the numbers of students in each class.

All 6th Graders
and new 7th and
8th graders

6th grade students and new 7th and 8th graders may come to the school for an in-person tour!

Call the school to schedule an appointment. (770-297-6270) Time slots are limited. They will be available between 3:00 and 7:30 on:

Monday, 8/17 for students with last names A - K

Tuesday, 8/18 for students with last names L - Z

For the sake of safety:

- We cannot allow you in the building before your appointment time.
- Students and parents will be escorted throughout the orientation and must stay in the designated areas through the tour.
- The student may come with two adults max. (No other children!)

Park in the front parking lot and wait in your car until five minutes before your appointment time. Enter at the bus-loading entrance. (At the end of the school, near the cafeteria. Look for the signs.)

During your orientation, you will:

1. Start in the cafeteria where you will meet the principal, and receive your student's class schedule and a Chromebook.
2. Be given a tour of the school.
3. Meet your 6th grade teachers on the 6th grade hallway.
4. Exit through the front entrance of the school.

This is the latest schedule and plan for Orientation. It was changed on 7/29 when the start date of school was moved to 8/24.

First, access your schedule by visiting Infinite Campus.

On Wednesday, August 19th or Thursday, August 20th go to Launchpoint and login. Then:

 - Watch the "Orientation Video" first. (This will include new expectations and schoolwide procedures.)
 - Then watch each of your teacher's introduction video.
