Dear Parent/Guardian,

Chestatee Academy students participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families, agree that this compact outlines how the parents, the entire school staff, and the students will share the responsibility for improved student academic achievement as well as describes how school and parents will build and develop a partnership that will help children achieve the State’s high standards. Parents, school personnel and administrators came together on April 16, 2024 to develop this compact. Parents offered several suggestions which were added to this compact. Meetings are held each year to review and revise the compact based on the school improvement goals and student’s needs, all parents are invited to participate in this revision. Title I Parent Survey is conducted to collect suggestions for improvement.

To understand how working together can benefit your child, it is first important to understand our district’s and school’s goals for student academic achievement.

Hall County School District Goals:

- **FY25 Goal 1: By the end of FY25, the percentage of students in each subgroup moving into the “Proficient” and Distinguished” levels of performance on the Georgia Milestones Assessments will increase by 2% in the “Proficient” and “Distinguished” levels of performance.**
- **FY25 Goal 2: By the end of FY25, increase the percentage of referred students who access school based mental health services in order to increase the overall school climate rating for HCSD by 1%.**

Chestatee Academy Goals and Focus:

- **By the end of FY25, 10% of students will increase one achievement level on the Georgia Milestones.**
- **By the end of FY25, our CCRPI Readiness Index score will increase to 80% as a result of improvement in at least 3 of 4 areas: staff and student attendance, discipline, resiliency, and engagement.**

- Provide students and parents with effective writer’s rubrics
- Provide students and parents with effective strategies to improve numeracy
- Provide parent workshops in each academic area throughout the school year
- Provide students & parents with course syllabus

Parent Responsibilities

- Communicate with teachers or school personnel regarding progress and/or concerns
- Watch Lexile Level video on the school website that explains Lexile levels and attend the parent workshop related to Lexile levels. If a parent is unable to attend the workshop, he/she can request the material shared during the workshop from the school

- Check and monitor grades in Infinite Campus, evaluate student progress toward Lexile & IXL goals, observe assignments in Canvas, and review any other educational tools
- Watch Georgia Milestone video on the school website explaining Georgia Milestones scores and learn strategies to improve level of performance on the Georgia Milestones assessment.
- Encourage the use of effective writing strategies to improve writing assignments
- Encourage the use of research-based strategies to improve numeracy
- Attend parent workshops in academic areas

Our Chestatee Academy Students will:

Student Responsibilities

- Regularly check grades in Infinite Campus and assignments in Canvas
- Regularly check Lexile and IXL levels and monitor progress
- Regularly attend school
- Communicate academic and wellness progress with caring adult and ask for help when needed
- Balance day to day life with knowledge of coping skills
- Routinely learn effective writing strategies and ways to strengthen writing style and structure
- Use literacy and writing strategies taught by my teachers to improve my level of performance on the Georgia Milestones assessment
- Attend parent/student workshops in academic areas
- Demonstrate The War Eagle Way by following the school rules & expectations
